

Wiesbaden's coordinates

Located in the heart of Europe and Germany, the state capital of Hesse is part of the vibrant FrankfurtRheinMain metropolitan region. Thanks to its extensive connections by road and rail, and its proximity to Frankfurt international airport, which is only 26 kilometres, or 16 miles, away, the city is easily accessible for international guests as well.

Arrive by coach?

There are free parking spaces for coaches between the RheinMain CongressCenter and the main railway station. All year round, passengers can get on and off in Paulinenstraße near the Kurhaus.

Going to use public transport?

The Wiesbaden Card Premium allows you to move comfortably through the city, either in a group or individually. Wiesbaden benefits from its central location, green spaces, and short travel distances, encouraging sustainable mobility. 


Rheingau Musik Festival

The Rheingau region is not only synonymous with wine but also with outstanding music. In the summer of 2025, the 38th Rheingau Music Festival, one of the largest music festivals in Europe, will be hosting over 150 concerts. From classical music to jazz and cabaret, there will be something for every taste. The special venues, including cultural monuments such as Eberbach Abbey, Schloss Johannisberg, Schloss Vollrads, wine estates, and Kurhaus Wiesbaden, make the festival a unique experience.

Cultural Route 65

The United States have their Route 66 – Wiesbaden now has Route 65. This cultural route connects over 25 institutions, including Museum Wiesbaden, the Hessian State Theatre, and the Museum Reinhard Ernst showcasing abstract art. The Nassauischer Kunstverein centre for contemporary art, which presents up-and-coming artists, and cinemas such as the Caligari FilmBühne are also part of the route. Many other cultural venues offer a varied programme of exhibitions, theatre, comedy, and concerts.



Discovering, adoring, finding out

Numerous famous artists have left their mark on Wiesbaden: Goethe, who enjoyed a stroll here, Dostoevsky, who gambled in the casino, Wagner, who worked on the "Master-Singers", and Jawlensky, who lived and painted in Wiesbaden. The city has long been a refuge for art and has become even more attractive when the Museum Reinhard Ernst, a new home for abstract art, opened in 2024. Highlights such as the International May Theatre Festival and the Rheingau Music Festival offer a diverse cultural programme, ranging from classical music to cabaret, and held in historical locations such as Eberbach Abbey and Schloss Johannisberg.

Museum Reinhard Ernst

For lovers of abstract art, the Museum Reinhard Ernst is a must. Right in the centre of Wiesbaden, businessman Reinhard Ernst had a unique art space created to make his impressive collection accessible to the public. The modern building, affectionately referred to as the "sugar cube", was designed by Fumihiko Maki, the renowned Japanese architect, and is also an architectural highlight.

Caligari FilmBühne

The Caligari, named after "The Cabinet of Dr Caligari", an Expressionist silent film, is Wiesbaden's municipal cinema. The arts and culture office puts on a varied programme in the stylishly restored Ufa film palace. Film history is brought to life here – ranging from German and European cinema to international arthouse, documentary, and short films.

Strolling, tasting, lingering

Wiesbaden's vibrant city centre is perfect for explorers who like to get out and about on foot. In just under a kilometre, you will find charming shops where slow food meets snacks, young fashion meets haute couture and craftsmanship meets sweet delicacies such as chocolates. PLEASURE is a top priority here: countless cafés, wine bars, and restaurants invite you to take a relaxing break. Afterwards, the discovery tour continues – through Mauergasse, Grabenstraße, Taunusstraße, across Kranzplatz square, or through the Bergkirchenviertel quarter.



Pleasure for all the senses – the Wiesbaden way of life

Experience Wiesbaden's diverse coffee culture: whether in the traditional Café Maldaner founded in 1859, Confiserie Kunder with its famous pineapple tartlets, the HEPA Kaffee-Rösterei coffee roastery, or at Café Blum – pleasure is the top priority here. In the charming quarters, you will also find small trendy cafés and authentic bars that invite you to linger and explore.

Must-sees!

Hochheim am Main meets Queen Victoria

The Queen of the United Kingdom herself tasted the Riesling in the midst of the vineyards in 1845. The Hochheim wine is still delivered to the British Royal Family today.

Rüdesheim cabin cable car and the famous Niederwald monument

Don't miss the romantic ride in a small cable car cabin up to the Niederwald park. The cabins hover high above the vines. Amazing views included.

St Hildegard Abbey in Rüdesheim

The abbey is a place of living spirituality and history. Enjoy the impressive abbey church, the abbey shop, and abbey café as well as events focusing on Hildegard's legacy.

Schloss Johannisberg

Anniversary – 250 years of Spätlese: the Spätlese, or late harvest wine, was discovered in 1775 at the world's first Riesling vineyard – Schloss Johannisberg in the Rheingau.

Eberbach Abbey

Nine hundred years of history, and still going strong. Founded in 1136, Eberbach Abbey has turned into an architectural gem of immeasurable value. The Hessian State Wineries are home to a world-famous vineyard – the Steinberg and the Steinberg cellar, which is one of the most modern wine-growing estates in Europe.

Schloss Vollrads

Eight hundred years of wine-growing tradition, 100% Riesling, ecological and sustainable cultivation. Enjoy wines in the vinothèque, on the courtyard terrace, on the nature trail, or in the estate restaurant.

Rheingauer Klostersteig

30 kilometres, 6 monasteries, pilgrimage and contemplation. Tip for mystery fans: download the Klostersteig for you(th) Stempelpass app and solve brainteasers along the trail.

Rheingau Riesling Loops

Fourteen circular hiking trails ranging between four and eight kilometres. Perfect for walkers and pleasure hikers.


